RESOLUTION NO. 2023-04**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH GRAND VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR A FLEET FUELING STATION AND REIMBURSEMENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-14 of the Home Rule Charter, the Town of Parachute (the “Town”) is empowered to provide services to other governmental units pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement approved by resolution or ordinance;

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 29-1-201, *et seq.* authorizes and encourages local governments to cooperate by contracting with one another for their mutual benefit;

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 39-27-102.5 I.(2).(bB)(II) permits a governmental entity that has a fuel tax exemption certificate to sell fuel, including gasoline, to another governmental entity so long as the fuel is used exclusively by the governmental entity in performing its governmental functions and activities.

WHEREAS, the Town has a fuel tax exemption as contemplated by the statute, so is permitted to sell fuel to other eligible governmental entities and, further, the Town owns and maintains a fuel facility at the Town’s public works property (the “Fuel Facility”).

WHEREAS, the Town and Grand Valley Fire Protection District (the “District”) wish to enter an Intergovernmental Agreement related to the Fuel Facility enclosed as **Exhibit A** (the “IGA”) to allow for the District’s use of the Fuel Facility and sharing of operation costs thereof.

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to approve the IGA and finds and determines that doing so is in the interest of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full and are adopted as findings.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby approves the IGA in substantially the same form as set forth in **Exhibit A**, as determined to be satisfactory to the Town Attorney, and authorizes the Mayor and Town Manager to execute the same. All actions heretofore taken by the Town Manager, and the other officers, employees, and agents of the Town in connection with the subject matter of this Resolution are hereby ratified, approved, and confirmed in all respects.

INTRODUCED, PASSED, ADOPTED, AND APPROVED by a vote of 4 to 0 of the Town Council of the Town of Parachute, Colorado at a regular meeting held at Town Hall in the Town of Parachute, Colorado, on the 19 day of January, 2023 and approved by the Mayor on the 19 day of January, 2023.
