

**TOWN OF PARACHUTE
ORDINANCE NO.717 -2017**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO, AMENDING FEE SCHEDULES IMPOSED FOR VIOLATIONS OF TITLES 10, 11, 12, AND 14 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Parachute (“Parachute” or the “Town”) is a Colorado home-rule municipality organized pursuant to Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and with the authority of the Parachute Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-5 of the Parachute Home Rule Charter requires the Town to establish penalties for violations of the Parachute Municipal Code (the “Town Code”) by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Title 7 of the Town Code authorizes the Parachute Board of Trustees to establish a penalty assessment schedule for criminal and traffic offenses under the Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds and believes that the current penalty schedules maintained by the Municipal Court for violations of the Town Code are inappropriate, have not been adjusted over time, and should be amended accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The Parachute Board of Trustees hereby adopts the amended Municipal Court Criminal Penalty Assessment and Fine Schedule attached as **Exhibit A** and incorporated by this reference. Any and all Municipal Court penalty fee schedules in conflict with those on Exhibit A are hereby repealed.

Section 3. The Parachute Board of Trustees hereby adopts the amended Municipal Court Traffic Penalty Assessment Schedule attached as **Exhibit B** and incorporated by this reference.

Section 4. No portion of this Ordinance No. 714 - Series of 2017 is intended to deprive the Municipal Court of its authority to impose penalties, fees, and sanctions or to otherwise limit the Municipal Court from the exercise of the full jurisdictional authority established under the provisions of the United States Constitution, the Colorado Constitution and Statutes, and the Parachute Home Rule Charter and Municipal Code.

INTRODUCED, READ, PASSED, ADOPTED, AND ORDERED PUBLISHED BY TITLE ONLY by a vote of 5 to 0 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Parachute, Colorado at a regular meeting held at Town Hall in the Town of Parachute, Colorado, on the 19th day of January, 2017 and approved by the Mayor on the 19th day of January, 2017.
