A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO, TERMINATING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY RELATED TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic, by Resolution No. 2020-14 and pursuant to C.R.S § 24-33.5-709, the Town Council declared a local disaster emergency related to COVID-19 (“COVID-19 Emergency Declaration”);

WHEREAS, in the light of widespread vaccinations against COVID-19 and guidance from the various public health agencies, the Town no longer needs to maintain its COVID-19 Emergency Declaration at this time;

WHEREAS, accordingly, the Town Council wishes to terminate the COVID-19 Emergency Declaration effective immediately and believes that doing so is in the best interests of the life, health, and safety of the Town and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARACHUTE, COLORADO:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as findings of the Town Council.

Section 2. **Terminate COVID-19 Emergency Declaration.** Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709, the Town Council hereby terminates its COVID-19 Emergency Declaration effective immediately.

INTRODUCED, PASSED, ADOPTED, AND APPROVED by a vote of 4 to 0 of the Town Council of the Town of Parachute, Colorado at a regular meeting held at Town Hall in the Town of Parachute, Colorado, on the 15TH day of July 2021 and approved by the Mayor on the 15TH day of JULY 2021.


